#### Dear Friends,

After a few years of cancelled courses due to Covid-19 we were finally able to arrange our popular winter training course for reserve officers again in March 2023. Thank you all for your participation and shown interest in the course!

In March 2024, the course will take place for the fifth time and we in Sverof, as a founding part of the Nordic Presidium, are happy to invite your organization to this event again. The main program will be approximately the same as previous years. However, based on feedback from previous courses, we have now harmonized the program for next year.

### What to expect

The course is an all inclusive week. The Swedish Armed Forces and Sverof will provide you with all necessary winter equipment. Your participants only need to bring their personal light uniform, together with a few smaller items that will be specified in a final course order late this fall.

The course encompasses training in cold weather behavior, ski marches, basic winter survival training, land navigation, prevention and treating of cold weather-related injuries and other field related topics. The participants will be spending 2-3 nights outdoor, obtain new or refresh knowledge related to challenging winter conditions and ultimately gain some new friends.




#### **Instructors**

As last year, Lieutenant Anton Kindlund will be the Course Commander. He and his instructors are all experienced in the art of winter training and will do their utmost to provide the course participants with an unforgettable winter experience – challenging yet rewarding.

# **Participants**

We are happy to expand the course from 25 to 30 individuals, excluding instructors. At this stage in the planning, we have an approximate view on how many individuals per nation may be participating. However, once we understand the exact number of potential participants, if needed, we will allocate the relevant number of individuals per nation, at our discretion. Should an invited nation decide not to participate or participate with a lesser number of persons than envisaged, such vacancies will be offered to other participating nations.

Your participants must not have any previous winter experience since this is a basic winter training course. However, this is also a good possibility to maintain winter training skills so do not hesitate to register for that purpose as well.

We do also kindly ask you to confirm that your nation's participants are covered by the relevant insurances regarding e.g. medical care, first aid, intensive care etc, in the unlikely event of unexpected incidents during the course.

The price for the entire week, including accommodation, food, instructors and equipment is  $\in$  750. The journey to and from the Camp Ånn is not included in this price.
